

Alaska Marine Highway System

TRAVELER'S ADVISORY

Federal regulations require that all passengers traveling to or from Bellingham and crossing the Gulf of Alaska must provide the following information:

- Full name
- Date of birth
- Citizenship

Passengers from all ports are advised of the following:

- All adult passengers must present government-issued photo identification prior to boarding the vessel.
- Noncommercial, unaccompanied vehicles must consent to a search of the vehicle prior to boarding the vessel.
- Baggage cart access is limited to ticketed passengers only.
- Visitors will not be permitted to board AMHS vessels unless escorted by AMHS personnel.
- Every vehicle will be checked for hazardous materials.
- Unattended baggage will not be permitted in the terminal buildings.
- Passengers transiting through various border check points are advised they should expect increased scrutiny and possible delays. Identification will be checked, and a birth certificate, passport, or government-issued picture ID will be required for entry.
- Additional measures may be imposed at the direction of the AMHS General Manager.
